AIKIDO YOSHINKAN BRISBANE DOJO COVID-SAFE ACTION PLAN

HYGIENE & CONTACT TRACING PROTOCOLS

- Students and visitors must use hand sanitiser upon entry and exit of the dojo
- Students must sign-in each session for attendance on the roll provided (plus electronic records of attendance will also be kept in support for tracing purposes if needed)
- Students must NOT attend training with any symptoms of sickness or unwell
- The dojo will be cleaned after each session mats mopped; training equipment cleaned etc. with disinfectant solution
- Students to wear a cleanly washed uniform for training in each session
- Students may wear a face mask anyone wishes to do so
- Students will wash hands with soap and sanitise immediately after any cough or sneeze
- Students will be recommended to download the government COVID-Safe App

TRAINING PROTOCOLS

- Unless contacting techniques practiced, socially distance between students of 1.5 metres in training and off the mats
- Classes limited to 45 people to allow for proper distancing on the mats and off (to remain in accordance with Qld. Gov COVID-19 regulations)
- The dojo's ventilation system is switched on throughout training times for proper ventilation

VISITORS AND FAMILY MEMBER PROTOCOLS

- Every parent, family member and visitor who steps inside the dojo must sign-in the visitor's book provided at the counter for tracing purposes if needed.
- Parents and family members will remain outside the dojo (drop-off only) and comply with Qld Gov. COVID-19 social distancing regulations
- Parents who need to remain at the dojo with a specific reason may do so but limited to five persons only in the lounge room
- Parents must drop students off and pick up after training sessions
- There will be no gatherings or social events at the dojo while state government restrictions remain
- Visitors are accepted to observe a class while they keep 1.5m social distancing and limited to three persons at a time

IN THE CASE OF A COVID-19 POSITIVE TEST AMONGST DOJO COMMUNITY

- The Dojo will close immediately
- The Dojo will be cleaned using disinfectant solution all surfaces and equipment
- All students and family members will be notified of the positive case and asked to quarantine for 2 weeks
- All students will be asked to take a test for COVID-19
- The Dojo will only reopen upon clear testing results of all students who were in contact with the person with the original positive test after two weeks
